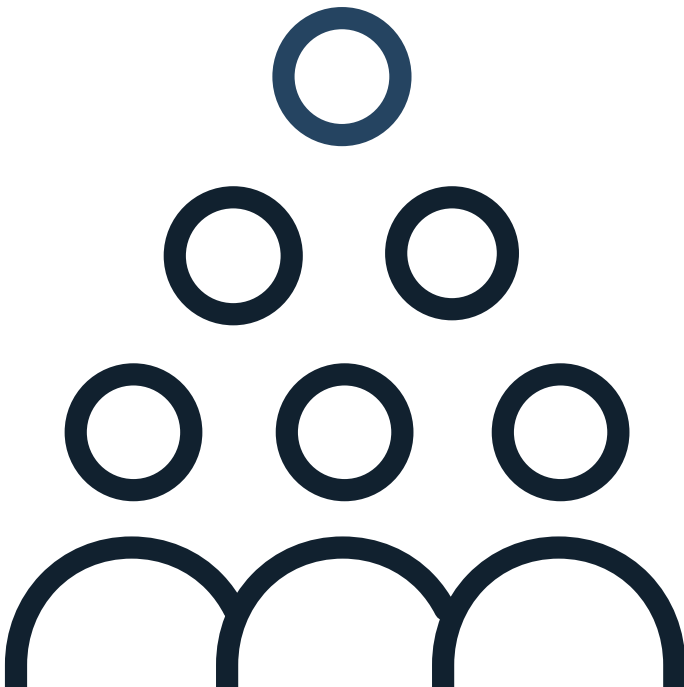

- Have the technical preparation and great motivation and commitment towards the program.
